EXODUS 16, (NSW)

We knew we wanted a strong chassis to handle the hundreds of kms of dirt corrugated and muddy roads that we have travelled and intend to travel. We wanted to be off grid for lengthy periods of time which meant plenty of power and water which the Exodus delivered. We like the experience of eating and cooking outside. The fridge pantry and stove are all conveniently positioned for easy access. But the table and seats inside gave us a refuge in bad weather

Everything that we considered in choosing the Exodus has exceeded our expectations. However since using the van we have made some great discoveries. On the road it follows smoothly behind the car and regardless of road conditions everything stays in place - not a teacup out of place. Once we arrive at the campsite the comforts of the Exodus become clear - the bed is comfortable; the van is light and airy(cool in hot weather but cosy in the cold); the diesel heater is very efficient; there is plentiful storage space; the indoor shower is a great luxury which is also easy to clean and the composting toilet means no more rendezvous at dump points.

The inverter and electrical system means we can not only boil an electric kettle but recharge e-bikes and electric chainsaws.

Our dealings with Exodus has been amazing.

Because the people selling the vans are also the ones making them it feels like a very personal connection. The updates during the build were much appreciated and the handover process was comprehensive while the two nights on the Central Coast gave us a supported space to try everything out. From our initial contact through to after sales support we have always felt that Exodus was as much invested in our van as we are.

You see lots of different off-road caravans on the highway but off the beaten track there are only a few and these tend to be Australian made. They know the conditions.

In our travels we were able to talk to Exodus owners who had crisscrossed Australia on remote roads, and they were able to discuss its capabilities in real circumstances that they had experienced, so the choice became obvious.

EXODUS 16, (NSW)

The number one reason we chose to purchase an Exodus 16 (E16) is that it is locally built.

Secondly the people who sell it, build it and understand what they are talking about.

Specifically relating to the model, we firstly were going to go with an E18, but after speaking with Scott & David and understanding the components and how well the space is utilised, we decided on the E16. Mostly because it has all the same features as the E18 but is more compact and lighter for towing.

EXODUS 16, (NSW)

The Exodus is significantly more expensive than other products of a similar size. The main reasons for us related to Build Quality, the fact that we knew our trailer was being built for us to our requirements, confidence that we could travel remotely for extended periods with little concern. Having had Complete Campsite campers previously we were also confident that if we had issues they are resolved simply. Other products of a similar size and intent did not offer the peace of mind for their product that the Exodus does. Although there is a fair price difference between the Exodus and the competition we still feel that we got value for money. This is a long term asset for us and we are confident that the Exodus will still be going strong when we want to move it on.

There are some areas that could be improved. As each build is done for each customer understanding what was standard and included was a little confusing. Colour schemes can be daunting and again there is challenges around looking for pictures that show different fit outs, options and colour schemes. 

Our new Exodus 14 Hybrid Camper I would like to highlight some of our favourite features. It's quick and easy to hook up and tow, it's light and manoeuvrable with on e axle and I like that it's only as wide as the cruiser and I don't need mirror extensions!

The fridge/microwave option also gives convenient access from the outdoor kitchen. The gas cooktop gives you peace of mind that you can cook anywhere even in the unlikely event that you run out of power.

I believe that your design, the flexibility in build and options as well as local sales and aftermarket support are well ahead of any of the competition.

We chose the 14 because in our opinion it is compact but large enough to accommodate all the features we need. There is no other camper like it!



EXODUS 18, (NSW)

We had an Exodus Kingston for 11 years before upgrading to our Exodus 18 in April 2025. You must have confidence in your van before heading so remote as recovery costs will be in the thousands of dollars if things go pear shaped and we had total confidence in our Kingston.

The lifetime warranty proves that David and the team also have total confidence in their products. The resale value on well made Australian campers is also far greater than imported campers. The Exodus range of campers has for the last 17 years been renowned for its almost indestructible construction which David has been involved in since the conception of the brand.

When we were looking at upgrading to a bigger camper, we had a wish list – the first being that our new camper had to continue to be able to get us to remote and rough tracks around Australia, have the same wheel track and width as the tow vehicle and a low profile so we could get through windy tracks with low branches.

We spent 2 years looking at different campers and couldn't decided between the Exodus 16 and one other manufacturer that was close to fitting our needs. But when the Exodus 18 was released, it was the size and layout we needed for full time travel. When we decided to order our Exodus 18, we found David and Corinne very helpfully with tailoring/customising the camper to suit our needs. They were always ready to help in any way during the whole build process and after we had taken delivery.

There have been no short cuts taken with the construction and fit out of the camper. The wiring for example is the correct size for running the inverter, batteries and solar panels. Yes, I have seen another high-end van were the wiring was about a third of the size it should have been. It's these little things which David and the team have taken the time to do properly.

We are having to rethink the way that we do our cooking. There is so much solar/battery power, there is no need to use gas for cooking unless you have extended periods of cloudy/bad weather. In hindsight we should have chosen the combined gas/induction cooker option.

The Exodus range of campers have a very well thought out water storage and filtration system, with the ability to pump water from tank to tank or pull water out of a creek which are important for remote travel.


Although we have only owned the camper for a short time, we have found that it tows extremely well behind our 2012 Pajero and 2019 DMax and the fuel consumption is surprisingly only a few litres per 100klm more than the old camper. We can't wait to take our Exodus 18 exploring the country



EXODUS 14, Dural (NSW)

We fell in love with the original EXODUS Kingston in 2009, but by the time we went to order one, things had moved on. A brand new model based loosely on the Kingston, but bigger and far more refined, was being developed by EXODUS campers with Dave's help. That development took longer than expected and is quite a story in itself, but our EXODUS was finally delivered in September 2011, the first of the current design with a fully moulded fibreglass interior fit-out.

To this day, after covering 106,000Km in it, we still delight in the stylish and beautiful interior – sleek glossy fibreglass, "felt" hoodlining, quality trim and fittings. Come to think of it, if nothing else you'd buy an EXODUS just because they look great! Lovely flowing lines; that delicate taper in the side walls; the gentle slope of the roofline.

That passenger side window? Lindy loves light, and looking at the shell of our unfinished camper at the Bluewater Yachts factory, she realised with dismay she wouldn't be able to look outside from bed. But no window small enough was on the market; a boat porthole was even considered; finally Russell from Bluewater and Lindy came up with the idea of turning a standard Dometic window on its side. Every subsequent EXODUS 14

has Lindy's window.

As an aside Dave and his team, without batting an eye lid, made it possible for her to have 2 more Dometic windows installed above the outside pantry, with a shelf inside instead of the cabinets. We think our interior is more open and light as a result. It seems true of EXODUS campers in general, that every effort is made at the construction phase to cater to the wishes of the new owner, with all sorts of custom features.

Speaking of storage, ample and clever storage is another of the many things to love about an EXODUS. That great pantry above the kitchen – sweet! And another similar set up above the basin inside. Under the seats, under the bed, drawers, plenty lockers, big boot in front.

We took the fold-around idea for the kitchen pull-out for granted first, but have come to appreciate how much more protected it is than the more common straight pull-out, and the slide-out next to it provides a "return". The Fiamma awning, too is a winner — so easy and quick to put up that we always pop it up, even for morning tea and lunch stops.



It has been an exciting adventure to choose our new caravan. Anita and I began with one non-negotiable, and that was that our new van had to be Aussie made. Further, we need a van that suited our camping requirements.

These basically include being able to get off the beaten track, away from civilisation yet without skimping on our comfort. Where we could enjoy nature, separate ourselves from technology and appreciate the simple things in life. We love cooking outdoors and sitting around a campfire, but also love the luxuries of home.

So, this is where our research began. We needed a rugged and durable van that was capable of getting us to these spots and was sealed against dust and water. It needed to be compact yet large enough for ample storage for our camping gear, fresh water and grey water, including room for a queen size bed, an ensuite bathroom and with sufficient internal space for protection from the elements.

It needed to be easy to tow with a large enough payload to be self-contained for extended periods. It needed a complete external kitchen, not just a stove and sink, but also an external fridge and pantry with sufficient space for our drinks, food, cookware, crockery and cutlery.

These requirements narrowed the potential options to just a few.

However, the key differentiators to choosing the EXODUS, other than the good looks was:

- The market leading external kitchen
- The 360Ah of Lithium battery power with 720w of solar and a 2000W inverter
- The ability to access and filter creek water
- The enclosed external shower pod, and
- 900kg payload.

The icing on the cake with choosing this van has been dealing with David Bradburn, the new owner of EXODUS campers. This is the year of COVID-19 and David and his team have been exceptional.

They are always keen to help or even have a quick chat to discuss ideas to help improve the functionality of the van.

EXODUS 16, Mona Vale (NSW)

After extensively researching Australian made hybrid caravan/camper trailers, we decided on an Exodus 14. We are empty nesters and use this for both our work travels and pleasure camping. One of the main features that really won us over with the Exodus was the build quality - from the monocoque shell, galvanised chassis, suspension, solar power, fittings & appliances - it is all first class.

The pop top lid allows us the choice of having it up for good head space and ventilation, or down so we can sleep better in harsh weather or noisy settings. For example, one night it got down to -5 degrees, but with the lid down and the diesel heater on for a bit before we went to sleep and then again once we were awake in the morning, we were very comfortable.

The ensuite at the rear is so simple to set-up/pack-down, taking only a couple of minutes, and gives a cleverly designed separate shower and change room layout. Paired with the optional internal compositing toilet, we have a fully "self-contained" solution, which broadens our options of where we can camp.

The kitchen offers a huge amount of storage and the slide out/rotate kitchen design allows you to be fully under the awning when necessary, whilst still being able to access the large pantry and fridge unit.

The Exodus 14 has far exceeded our expectations. It is beautifully safe and stable to tow and we know it has the capability to go wherever we have the adventurous courage to take it.
